




RFTA Railroad Right-of-Way Ownership Atlas

Issue Date: January 10, 2020

- Prepared using ownership research data from the Railroad Right-of-Way Survey prepared by Farnsworth Group, Inc. in 2007/2008. Recorded at Reception No.'s 784 through 789 in the Records of Garfield County, Colorado, in Book 1 at Pages 704 through 715 in the Records of Eagle County, Colorado, and at Reception No.'s 555084 through 555087 in the Records of Pitkin County, Colorado, plus additional research data obtained since the Survey.
- Specific ownership information is from historic railroad and public records research performed by Farnsworth Group, Inc. and did not include title commitments or any other title company research.
- Municipal boundaries from Garfield & Pitkin Counties.
- Initial publication date of this Atlas: December 19, 2012, revised January 2020.
- The RFTA RR ROW shown on these atlas sheets has been updated since the 2008 survey to reflect the current ROW boundaries as of August 31, 2019.




Conservation Covenant Area Hatch


